



NEW for the 2023-2024 school year: FREE asthma medication, equipment, and resources Thanks to Public Act 100-0726, schools in Illinois are allowed to store and administer "undesignated" asthma medication to students, staff, and school visitors experiencing a medical emergency..

Now funded, all K-12 schools are eligible for free life-saving asthma medication and resources.

The Asthma and Allergy Foundation of America chapter in Missouri has been operating the RESCUE program for 12 years and has proven experience working with providers, pharmacists, and school districts to keep kids safe.
